
Who we are

Scope

This policy applies to all supply chain activity delivered with funding received from the European Social Fund during the contract years 16/17, 17/18, 18/19.

Rational

Bauer Academy engages with supply chain partners to enable us to deliver a broad and diverse range of provision across a wide geographical area.

All supply chain partners are expected to pass Bauer Academy's during diligence process which includes (but not limited to):

- A financial health check
- A track record of high quality provision
- Comprehensive policies and procedures
- Robust Self Assessment & Quality Improvement plans

Bauer Academy's management fee is a maximum of 20% across a contract as a whole, payments are made to partners monthly following robust quality assurance of information provided.

Bauer Academy is committed to our supply chain partners and offer as part of the management fee:

- Access to Bauer Media brands
- A dedicated point of contact
- Data inputting and reporting on behalf of the supply chain partner
- Support, advice, regular visits and audits to ensure compliance with ESFA performance and management rules (including ESF)
- Quarterly meetings to share best practise, information and good news stories with supply chain partners.

This policy will be emailed to partners on commencement of any contract and will be published on our website. At A minimum it will be reviewed annually.
